- 2. Application to be filed in timely fashion, preferably 3-6 months in advance.
- 3. Active member or regular attendee of Ebenezer Mennonite Church or its youth program.
- 4. Parental approval needed for all minors.
- 5. Choose one of the missions related books off of the attached list and write a summary of what you learned. (See Page 3)
- 6. Report to be made to the congregation. The report may be made either verbally to the congregation in a regular service (time permitting) or in writing.
